- a) Competitive must be EA registered OR b) LEGs members must be LEGs member (not both)

ENTRY FEES.

LEGs Members Classes :- \$15 per class

Official Classes:-

\$25 LEG Members per class, \$30 Non LEG members per class

Each competition is restricted to 35 horses on a "first in basis", receipt of correct entry and payment. Reserve lists will be maintained, riders on the reserve list at any level that are not offered a ride, will be refunded the full amount for that competition only. Riders who are offered a ride and do not accept, will forgo all entry fees for that competition. This will be enforced at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

** <u>ALL LEG MEMBERS ARE TO SUPPLY A HELPER FOR A MINIMUM OF TWO HOURS -</u> THIS WOULD BE APPRECIATED.**

HOWEVER - IT WOULD BE GREATLY APPRECIATED IF ANY RIDER COULD HELP OR SUPPLY A HELPER - FAMILY, FRIEND, STRAPPER, OR ANYONE THAT HAS A SPARE HOUR (OR MORE)!

Note to Official Competitors, the following information is required at time of entry:

Bridle Number, Horse EA number, Owner EA number, Rider EA number

*If this information is not provided prior to the closing date, your entry will not be accepted.

COMPETITION DETAILS

Prize Schedule:

- Ribbons 1st to 6th.
- Prize money/Goods to 3rd at the discretion of the OC (all classes with 5 or more competitors on the day)
- The OC reserves the right to reduce prize money to 1st place only where competitions have fewer than 5 starters on the day of competition. Prize money may be reduced at the OC's discretion subject to the number of entries per class.

**Prize Collection: The rider or a delegated representative MUST collect all prizes at the presentation on the day of Competition. Prize money only may be posted to the owners, NO ribbons/sashes or goods will be posted.

- Late or incomplete entries **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**. Entries must be made online through www.nominate.com.au by midnight Sunday 27th July 2014.
- Entry Refunds Total Entry fees less \$10 administration will be refundable upon receipt of a doctor's or veterinary certificate (at the discretion of the OC) dated and time stamped within 24 hours of the event concluding. These can be submitted to: LEGs Treasurer, P.O. Box 49 Marburg. QLD. 4346

Event Cancellation

If the event or competitions part thereof are to be cancelled an administration fee of \$10 will be retained by the LEG Inc

Horse Health Declarations (HHD) – Must be accepted with Liability Waiver when you complete your online entry form. For full Biosecurity Guidelines and information please refer to http://www.daff.qld.gov.au/animal-industries/horses/ – remember DO NOT TAKE SICK HORSES TO AN EVENT. By accepting this declaration you declare that the horse/s on this entry will only be brought to the event if they are in good health. You will be giving your authorisation for the designated OC Steward to call for veterinary inspection of the horse/s on this entry and in your care should they be showing signs of illness at any time during the course of the event. You also agree to pay any veterinary fees incurred as a result of this.

HHD FORMS WILL NOT BE REQUIRED TO BE HANDED IN ON THE DAY.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY—ALL COMPETITIONS IT IS THE RIDERS RESPONSIBILITY TO KNOW THE CURRENT RULES UNDER WHICH THEY WILL COMPETE

- The event is conducted using the current Equestrian Australia Dressage Rulebook and FEI rules including all Codes of Conduct and their relevant Annexure at both National and International levels. These are available for download from the Equestrian Australia website www.equestrian.org and www.fei.org.
- All riders and horse owners must be current financial members of Equestrian Australia to compete in Competitive Classes. To compete in LEGs Members Class must be current financial members of Lockyer Equestrian Group.
- All horses competing in competitive Classes must be registered with Equestrian Australia.
- NO PENDING registrations will be accepted.
- NO HC entries will be allowed.
- Bridle Numbers for Competitive Classes All registered Queensland dressage horses have been allocated a
 bridle number and this number MUST be worn on both sides of the horse when being ridden during the event. This
 number must match the number quoted on the entry form. s
- Bridle Numbers for LEGs Members Classes If LEGs members do not have a bridle number, one will be issued when draw is completed. If you do not have your own set of numbers a set of two will be available for collection at office on morning of competition and these are yours to use for all LEGs competitions.
- Stallion Disks- Green stallion disks must be identifiable on both sides of the stallion or colt. Stallions must abide
 by Equestrian Australia Stallion Guidelines. <u>Stallions must be stabled and not tied to the outside of a</u>
 truck or trailer.
- Gear Check:
 - Riders must present for a visual gear check at least 10 minutes before their ride time, presented in CORRECT competition attire compliant with Section 2 of the 2013 Equestrian Australia Dressage Rulebook.
 - Riders must stand their horses' whilst undergoing gear check.
 - Combinations may be subject to a detailed gear check after they have completed their test.
- EA tests may be commanded.
- Protests: Must follow procedures laid out in Section 1.4 of the Current Equestrian Australia Dressage Rulebook and current FEI Rules.
- Protests must be in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$150.
- Swabbing may occur at this event.
- Oversubscription rules will be strictly enforced as mentioned in the provisional timetable.
- Tests not collected can be posted at a cost of \$3. Envelopes will be provided at the location of test collection.
- A full copy of the draw will be available on the website and will be emailed to all competitors.
- Prize money will be forwarded to the owners. Owners' details are to be supplied on the entry form or the prize money will be considered forfeited and not forwarded on.
- Dress Code: Formal attire to be worn for both Competitive & LEGs Members Classes

 coat & tie/stock, beige/white jodhpurs/breeches.
- Attention LEGs members Members Classes are not divided into senior/master/junior divisions. Results are not included in LEGs end of year award tally.

GENERAL EVENT INFORMATION.

Dogs: On the ground are not the preferred option. If present they must be on a leash and under complete control at all times. They are not allowed in the canteen or competition areas (including the showground and grandstand) if owners or riders have dogs in these areas this will entail **elimination.**

Camping and Accommodation: \$15/night both powered and unpowered sites are available. These are not allocated and are on a first in basis. There are a number of motels and B&B's in the Lockyer Valley.

Horse Feed and Bedding: Horse feed is the responsibility of the competitor. Stable bedding will be supplied.

Stabling: (No temporary overnight yards of any kind will be allowed).

- Preference for stabling will be given to those that have booked with entries. Cannot guarantee availability of stables on the day.
- > \$25/day or part thereof.
- ➤ <u>BOND FEE:</u> A separate payment of \$50 per stable must be paid at time of booking stable. Refundable upon departure if stable/s pass inspection and are locked by the Stable Manager.
